# 'Owning my Space' Leadership & Life skills program for graduates (youth corpers)

May 14, 16, 17, 2024: Victoria Island Programme Report

'Owning My Space' Leadership and Life Skills programme is an initiative of boys to MEN Foundation. Its core purpose is to support male graduates transition into effective contributors to society. Through real-world conversations, focused discussions, and core training modules, this programme provides a path to personal development and growth. Founded in 2017 by Mrs. Ifeoma I. Idigbe, the Foundation acknowledges the challenges young men face in trying to find their place in the world and is focused on supporting males to be the best they can be. It recognizes the challenge of absent mentors and poor role models, toxic masculinity, and oppressive societal expectations on young me. The modules are designed to tackle these challenges and foster a shift in their mindsets and attitudes towards distorted cultural norms that many young men may have adopted.

On May 14, 16, 17, 2024, the Foundation ran an Owning My Space programme with three cohorts of corpers from the National Youth Service Corps (NYSC) Victoria Island LGA, sponsored by Zenith Bank Plc. Facilitators engaged participants through presentations and discussions on a range of topics, including The Real World (a discussion of a video on monologues from *About Men: Random Poems, Monologues and Reflections*) as well as the challenges men face in today's world, a Leadership module, including Emotional Intelligence; Personal Branding, Managing Your Finances, Public Speaking and Navigating a Corporate Career facilitated by Nonso Elue of Zenith Bank. The impact of these sessions was measured using participants feedback. There were 86 participants, corpers from the Victoria Island LGA.
